

- Subject : Installation of instruments and equipment which are not part of the minimum equipment
- Effectivity : All DG and LS sailplanes and powered sailplanes, whose TCs are held by DG
- Accomplishment : None, optional
- Reason : Installation of instruments and equipment which are not part of the minimum equipment is common practise with gliders and powered sailplanes.
Instructions and limitations for such installations are given with this TN.
- Instructions : 1. The installation of instruments and equipment may be accomplished according to the working instructions for TN DG-G-07.
If these instructions are followed no individual STC needs be issued for this work and approved by EASA.
2. After installation provide a new weighing report by calculation or execute a new weight and balance. Alter the equipment list.
File weighing report and equipment list into the aircraft logs.
Enter the data in the weighing report in the flight manual (if existent).
Enter min. cockpit load in the cockpit data placard if load changed.
- Material : Working instruction for TN DG-G-07
- Weight and balance : New weighing report is necessary after installation of instruments and equipment.
- Remarks : Instructions No. 1 may be executed by the pilot/owner himself and are to be inspected and entered in the aircraft logs by a licensed inspector.
- Instructions No. 2:
1. EASA countries: The actions have to be performed in a Part -145 approved organisation, or in a Part M, Subpart F approved organisation according to the regulations of the Part M and released according to M.A.801.
 2. Non EASA countries: The actions have to be performed in a licensed workshop or by a certified mechanic.
- All instructions are to be inspected and entered in the aircraft logs by a licensed inspector.
